This table shows export destinations receiving at least 5 percent of total exports for the top 36 export commodities. This table also includes an additional 8 commodities for which California accounts for more than 85 percent of exports from the United States, or for which reliable export data was available. For those commodities that California produces 85 percent or greater of exports from the United States, percentages were equal to national percentages in each country. For those commodities that California produces less than 85 percent of exports from the United States, the main sources for destination percentages were California port data and Canadian import data. However, California port data may not accurately reflect export destinations for some products from California. In those cases, adjustments were made using industry information.
